<p>*On July 6, 2007, MCWA conveyed its 4th priority entitlement to its Mohave County contract service area. Through the contracting process it retained the right to continue to use the entitlement for irrigating its Cibola Valley farmland until it is needed for M&I use in Mohave County. Two subcontracts for 2,139 acre-feet each were executed for Bullhead City and Lake Havasu City. The volume of 5,997 acre-feet was first assigned to MCWA and then conveyed to the MCWA contract service area. Only the 'conveyance' volume of 5,997 acre-feet was included in the "conveyance" totals above; the 'assignment' volume of the same was not counted in 'assignments', so it would not be double-counted in the Grand Total.</p>											
1	September 25, 2007 - Arizona Game and Fish Commission (AGFC) acquired 1,419 acre-feet of Fourth-Priority entitlement, 750 acre-feet of Fifth-Priority entitlement and 1,000 acre-feet of Sixth-Priority entitlement from Mohave County Water Authority (MCWA) through a conveyance. The entitlement is to be used for Multi-Species Conservation Program (MSCP) purposes on Cibola Valley land that the Commission also acquired from MCWA . October 9, 2008, the AGFC acquired an additional 1,419 acre-feet of entitlement from the Hopi Tribe to be for MSCP purposes on its Cibola property.										
2	October 25, 2006 - B&F Investment LLC acquired 60 acre-feet of Fourth-Priority entitlement from Cibola Resources, Inc. Cibola Resources had initially acquired the 60 acre-feet from Cibola Valley Irrigation and Drainage District through an assignment and immediately conveyed the entitlement to B&F for domestic use in the Ehrenberg area.										
3	May 1, 2009 - Cha Cha, LLC acquired 1,896 acre-feet of 4th priority irrigation entitlement, 960 acre-feet from Auza Farms and 936 acre-feet from Dulin Farms . An additional 204 acre-feet was recommended for Cha Cha (formerly Glen Curtis Citrus) due to its acquisition of existing Yuma area farmland from Beattie SW Farms. There had been no previous entitlement associated with that farmland. Currently, Cha Cha, LLC's irrigation entitlement is 2,100 acre-feet of 4th priority.										
4	Through several assignment actions, Cibola Valley Irrigation and Drainage District (CVIDD) has reduced its entitlement from 24,120 acre-feet of 4th priority, 3,000 acre-feet of 5th priority and 4,000 acre-feet of 6th priority to its current total entitlement of 12,626 acre-feet. December 2004, CVIDD assigned 5,997 acre-feet of 4th priority each to The Hopi Tribe and to MCWA . Both entities also acquired 750 acre-feet of 5th priority and 1,000 acre-feet of 6th priority entitlement. In 2006, CVIDD assigned 60 acre-feet of 4th priority entitlement to Cibola Resources and in 2008 assigned another 2,700 acre-feet of 4th priority to Arizona Recreational Facilities, Inc (now GSC, Inc.) . CVIDD's 4th priority entitlement includes 300 acre-feet for domestic water uses. In December 2014, CVIDD assigned 240 acre-feet of 4th priority entitlement to GSC Farm, LLC . July 24, 2018 CVIDD assigned 621.48 acre-feet of 4th priority Colorado River water to Western Water LLC and 300 acre-feet of 4th priority entitlement to Red River Land Co. LLC .										
5	December 22, 2015 - Ehrenberg Improvement Association (EIA) acquired 150 acre-feet of 4th priority Colorado River water from LaPaz County through a partial assignment. The 150 acre-feet is added to their existing entitlement for a total of 650 acre-feet 4th priority Colorado River water to be used for domestic uses.										
6	November 15, 2012 - EPCOR acquired 14 acre-feet of 4th priority Colorado River water from Arizona Recreational Facilities through a conveyance. The entitlement is to be used for domestic uses; This was added to their existing entitlement for 1,420 acre-feet of 4th priority, for a current entitlement to 2,913.3 acre-feet of 4th priority.										
7	August 3, 2005 - First American Title Insurance Agency of Mohave, Inc. acquired present perfected right # 11 for 1,050 acre-feet irrigation water from Hopal . The land associated with the right is located within Mohave Valley Irrigation and Drainage District's contract service area.										

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8	September 4, 2008 - GSC Farm, LLC (formerly Arizona Recreational Facilities (ARF)) aquired 2,700 acre-feet of fourth priority irrigation entitlement from CVIDD . November 15, 2012 - ARF conveyed 14 acre-feet of fourth priority irrigation entitlement to EPCOR Water Arizona Inc. for domestic use. February 25, 2013 - ARF conveyed 12.7 acre-feet of fourth priority irrigation entitlement to Lake Havasu City for domestic use. On December 23, 2013 ARF assigned 2,673.3 acre-feet to GSC Farms, LLC . December 3, 2014 - CVIDD assigned 240 acre-feet of 4th priority entitlement to GSC Farm, LLC .										
9	October 9, 2008 - The Hopi Tribe transferred 1,419 acre-feet of its 5,997 acre-feet 4th priority entitlement to the Arizona Game and Fish Commission . June 9, 2008 - Hopi Tribe conveyed 50 acre-feet to Springs del Sol Water Improvement District . June 10, 2008 - Hopi Tribe conveyed 250 acre-feet to La Paz County .										
10	September 27, 2007 - JRJ Partners (formerly Jessen Farms & Family, LTD) aquired 1,080 acre-feet of fourth priority entitlement from Dulin Farms .										
11	June 10, 2008 - La Paz County acquired a total of 500 acre-feet of 4th priority entitlement. The entitlement acquired by La Paz County had originally been intended for 2 other water providers located within La Paz County. When those entities were unable to acquire the entitlement, which entailed 250 acre-feet each from The Hopi Tribe and Mohave County Water Authority (MCWA), La Paz County stepped in as the recipient so that the water would be available to support future growth in the county. The acquisition entailed 4 transfer actions (two 50 acre-feet and two 200 acre-feet increments from both the Tribe and MCWA were conducted simultaneously). December 22, 2015 - LaPaz County assigned 150 acre-feet of 4th priority Colorado River water to Ehrenberg Improvement Association (EIA) . LaPaz County now has 350 acre-feet of Fourth-Priority entitlement for domestic use.										
12	February 25, 2013 - Lake Havasu City acquired 12.7 acre-feet of 4th priority entitlement from Arizona Recreational Facilities through a conveyance. The entitlement is to be used for domestic uses. This was added to their existing entitlement for 19,180 acre-feet of 4th priority water and the priority 5 and/or 6 of an 'unspecified' amount noted in the table above.										
13	May 7, 2014 - McAlister Family Trust aquired 40 acre-feet of 4th priority entitlement from Maurice L. McAlister .										
14	December 2004 - Mohave County Water Authority (MCWA) aquired 5,997 acre-feet of Fourth-Priority, 750 acre-feet of Fifth-Priority and 1,000 acre-feet of Sixth-Priority irrigation entitlement from CVIDD . On July 6, 2007, MCWA conveyed its 4th priority entitlement to its Mohave County contract service area. Through the contracting process, it retained the right to continue to use the entitlement for irrigating its Cibola Valley farmland until it is needed for M&I use in Mohave County. September 25, 2007 the MCWA conveyed 1,419 acre-feet of 4th priority, 750 acre-feet of fifth priority and 1,000 acre-feet of sixth priority entitlement to the AGFC to use for MSCP purposes on the associated Cibola Valley land that it acquired simultaneously from MCWA . The remainder of MCWA's entitlement will continue to be used to temporarily to irrigate farmland prior to its conversion for use under the MSCP . In June 2008, MCWA conveyed a total of 300 acre-feet of 4th priority entitlement. The first 50 acre-feet were conveyed to Springs del Sol Water Improvement District , while 250 acre-feet were conveyed to La Paz County . The current entitlement is noted in the table above.										
15	August 12, 2005 - North Baja LLC aquired 480 acre-feet from Jamar Produce Corporation for use within the same contract service area. The conveyance involved a partial change of use from irrigation only to irrigation and industrial uses.										
16	March 27, 2003 - Pasquinelli, Gary J. aquired 486 acre-feet of the irrigation entitlement from the Ansel Hall . Due to reduced irrigated acreage and the lack of continued need, the remaining 24 acre-feet of the original 510 acre-feet entitlement was placed into the unallocated 4th priority entitlement category.										
17	June 9, 2008 - Springs del Sol Water Improvement District acquired 50 acre-feet of Fourth-Priority entitlement each from MCWA and The Hopi Tribe through a conveyance totaling 100 ac-ft.										
18	August 31, 2018 - Gabrych acquired 4,500 acre-feet of Fourth-Priority entitlement form Rayner Ranches though assignment.										
19	August 23, 2018 - Ott acquired 480 acre-feet of Fourth-Priority entitlement form George Ogram though assignment.
