4 **MEETING DETAILS**

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6 The meeting took place at the ADWR offices located at 1110 W. Washington
7 Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 on October 3, 2019 at 9:00 am. ADWR sent written
8 confirmation of the meeting details to all claimants, landowners, and objectors on the
9 court-approved mailing lists for these contested cases in September 2019.

10 Present at the meeting were James Meza, Becky Eden, Ana Marquez, Cera Lange
11 and Kimberly Parks representing ADWR, Mark McGinnis, Rodney Held, and Tim
12 Skarupa representing the Salt River Project ("SRP"), and the claimants, Matt and Anna
13 Magoffin.

14 Attending telephonically were Luke Christian representing the Tonto Apache
15 Tribe, Brad Pew representing ASARCO, John Burnside representing BHP Copper, and
16 Jay Tomkus representing the Yavapai-Apache Nation.

17 **MEETING OUTCOMES**

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19 After a brief discussion of the claims and well location, it was determined that the
20 Magoffins needed additional time to sort out their claims and determine the status of any
21 Statements of Claimant (39s) that may apply to those claims. All of the objecting parties
22 represented at the meeting indicated that they would be willing to work to resolve the
23 objections in this case once they have more information on the claims. ADWR staff
24 remained in the meeting to assist the Magoffins in sorting out some of their claims. 39-
25 6486 and 39-12022, which are the applicable Statements of Claimant for this case, have
26

1 now been transferred into the name of the Magoffins based on documentation provided to
2 ADWR.

3 **NEXT STEPS**

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5 The parties have requested ADWR to schedule another meeting in 90 days, at
6 which time the claimants hope to have filed proper documentation to support their claims
7 and the parties hope to be able to reach an agreement.




