ADWR-

Section 9. Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity, Governing Law and Venue

1. The CRIT hereby agrees to a limited waiver of its sovereign immunity from suit by ADWR solely for the purpose of interpretation or enforcement of this Agreement.

This language assumes legitimacy of legality of former, current and future 'stake holders' control of water in the basin to include Secretary of Int, Chief of Council, CRIT, ADWR, {etc. et al} and appears exclusive of representation of countless impacted entities within the watershed.
