

ADWR REGULATORY AGENDA FOR 2020

This document was produced by the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) to comply with A.R.S. § 41-1021.02. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1021.02(D), ADWR may undertake a rulemaking even if the rulemaking is not included on the annual regulatory agenda.

Note: On January 9, 2019, Governor Ducey issued Executive Order 2019-01, “Moratorium on Rulemaking to Promote Job Creation and Customer-Service-Oriented Agencies; Protecting Consumers Against Fraudulent Activities.” The Executive Order provides that a state agency shall not conduct any rulemaking without the prior written approval of the Office of the Governor. Currently, ADWR has not requested permission to conduct any rulemakings in 2019, but anticipates seeking permission in 2020 to conduct the rulemaking described in Section I below.
