I am against the implementation of an INA and feel strongly that a more global and comprehensive approach involving all parties to preserve ground water resources in the area.*

*It appears to me that in the presentation to the community by ADWR earlier this month, the aquifer is not in depletion to the point it merits the INA designation. It also appears to me that the continued statement that 80,000 acres is owned or controlled by farmers is incorrect and reported to create a speactor of fear about future agriculture water uses.*

*Only by working with the community, city and county, can we properly prepare a long term solution which would be beneficial to everyone. Please do not take the steps to form an INA at the present time and call for all the parties to come together in the spirit of cooperation to find a long term solution to our water issues.*
