Hello Sharon:

I attended the meeting today at the Kingman Administration building and "Emily" stated that some of the data you guys used was old and some only had current readings. When I moved out here from California with no idea what a well was, I had some problems with being on a shared well and nobody on the well having any idea where their water came from! We also had people not paying their share as per the escrow agreement and a host of other problems. Suffice to say I set out to become as my son now calls me a "well-ologist"! Over the past four years I have done a lot of research and my paying neighbors now respect me for my research and tenacity and those that don't pay still hate me. That is ok.

But my purpose for emailing you is to let you know that I have old and new data that I am opening for you to use as you see fit. I hope it helps in your decision making or future studies. I would like to go more into depth but I have to leave tomorrow for California for a week of doctors appointments (I have serious medical issues and all my doctors are still in California). So I will tell you what I have done so far:

Here is a link on that page that shows the static level and other information that the state created in 2002 when the well was installed, the static level at that time was estimated to be 640 feet.

Here is a link on the same page to a "fact sheet" that I created that says the static level as of this year is at an estimate 629 feet or 11 feet down from 2002. Of course originally there were four families on the well and there are now 16 with four undeveloped parcels that could potentially make a total of 21 homes on our well so the 11 foot drop over 20 years will obviously get worse now that there are more families on it.
