We strongly SUPPORT the creation of an INA for the Hualapai Basin.

The evidence presented so far demonstrates that water currently is being withdrawn from the basin faster than it can replenish. We may live in the present, but we must look at the future rather than wait for the situation to become critical to act.

We are in an extended drought and this a desert. The Hualapai Basin does not have an infinite supply of water. The more corporate irrigation wells that are drilled, the faster this water will deplete. Where will water come from to support the 1,000's of residents here? Kingman does not have access to CAP canals or the Colorado River water. Corporate Interests will simply move on to another area. They don't live here.

No harm would be done to our long-standing ranchers nor to small landowners who want to grow their own crops to feed their families since they can still drill both exempt and non-exempt wells under an INA.

Therefore, I strongly urge you to create an INA for the Hualapai Basin to protect our future here as well as that of future generations.
