Dear Ms. Scantlebury,

I am writing this in **opposition to INA** implementation in Hualapai Valley

1. The difference between actual water uses and the water use report by the USGS studies are not accurate and misleading.
2. We are using improved and technologically advanced methods for our irrigation operation which has reduced water usage dramatically.
3. We have spent substantial amount of money clearing the farm ground, irrigation, ripping and well drilling. We have put non refundable deposits for further agriculture activities, which will substantially affect the future of businesses if INA is approved.
4. Farming and ranching are significant economic drivers in Mohave County.
5. It also appears to me that the continued statement that 80,000 acres is owned or controlled by farmers is incorrect and reported to create a Specter of fear about future agriculture water uses.
6. I believe the aquifer is not in depletion to the point it merits the INA designation, hence I request you to disapprove it.
